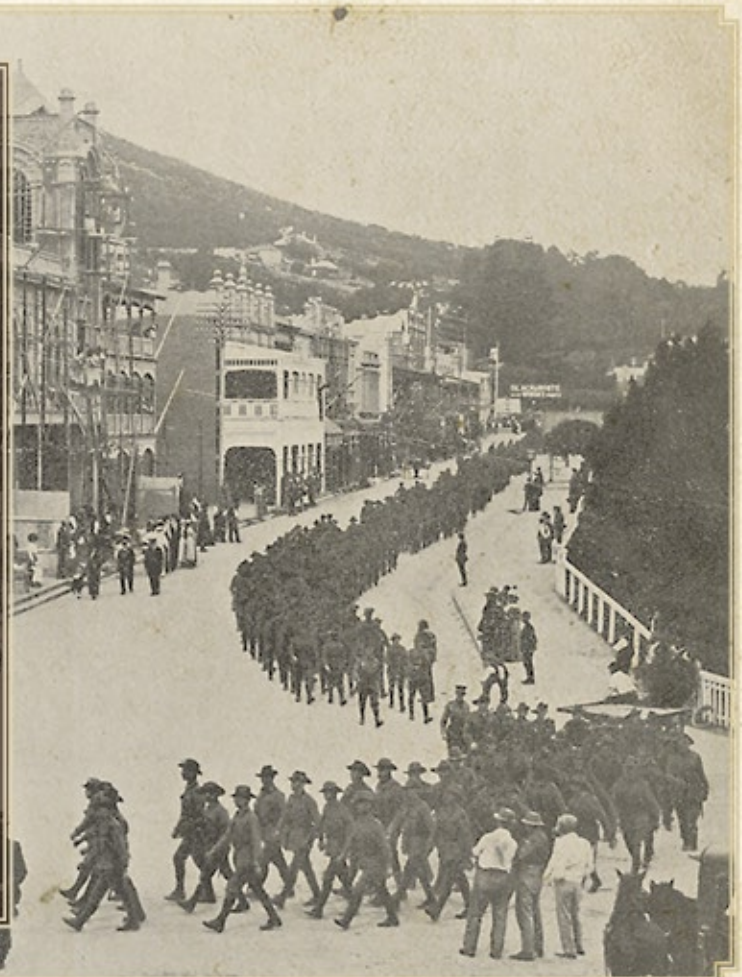
ARMISTICE DAY COMMUNITY CELEBRATION
